STONY METEORS
overwhelming bulk of these meteorites consists of the Fe-Ni-alloys kamacite and taenite. Minor minerals, when occurring, often form rounded nodules of troilite or graphite, surrounded by schreibersite and cohenite.
I occur as plate shaped inclusions, which show up on cut surfaces as cm-long and mm-thick lamellae.
